

Changes in pick-up points for Work to Home (W2H) buses

Tuas Boulevard Yard

With Effect 4 September 2023

Overview

- With effect from 4 September 2023, the pick-up points for work to home (W2H) transport will be shifted to the auxiliary road in the yard premises. This will only apply to nondormitory transport services.
- Pick-up along the main road (Tuas South Boulevard) will cease from 4 September 2023.
- This change applies to all non-dormitory transport pick-up including weekends.
- Due to large number of buses picking up at the same time and space limitation, <u>Zoning pick-up</u> will be implemented.
- Different bus route will be assigned to different Zones for pick ups.
- The following slides will show more details on the Zonings and bus pick-up points.



- The buses in Zone A will not stop according to sequence.
- Passengers boarding the buses from Zone A should wait along the sheltered walkway if the bus has not arrived.




Zone D

- Passengers boarding the buses from Zone D can wait at the sheltered bus bay at Corporate building if the bus has not arrived.

- There will be no Zoning for the 1900 hrs pick up.
- Fixed pick-up points are assigned to the above bus routes.
- Please proceed to the respective pick-up points as above for boarding.

Routes with fixed pick-up point




 Passengers boarding the buses in the following table should proceed to the fixed pick-up point for boarding. There will be <u>NO</u> Zoning for the following routes.

No Vehicle Movement Zone



- A "No Vehicle Movement Zone" will be implemented. The affected area will be within the Corporate building entrance barrier until
 the Multi-Storey Carpark (MSCP) exit.
- The "No Vehicle Movement Zone" will be implemented from 1710 hrs to 1740 hrs & 1840 hrs to 1905 hrs.
- Vehicles will not be allowed to move within the "No Vehicle Movement Zone" during the implemented hours. This will exclude buses. Private cars / Taxi pick-ups will be diverted to pick up along the main road.
- Drivers exiting the MSCP are allowed to turn left to leave the premise. Security officers will be deployed to facilitate traffic
 movement exiting from MSCP. Please take instructions from the Security officers on duty.
- Purpose of the "No Vehicle Movement Zone" is to facilitate human traffic flow during end work time for boarding of buses.

Pick-up point for Work to Home (W2H) Weekend & Public holidays transport



- The pick up point for Weekend/Public holidays outbound transport will be shifted to the sheltered bus bay located at the Corporate building as shown above, with effect from 4th September 2023.
- Pick up along the main road, Tuas South Boulevard, will cease with effect from 4th September 2023.

FAQs

Why is there a change in the pick up point for Work to Home (W2H) SWAT services?

The pick up points will be shifted into the Yard premises to increase the safety of all passengers. This will bring the pick up points nearer to sheltered areas and reduce the need of waiting under the rain during bad weather conditions.

How does the zoning work?

Buses allocated to the respective Zones will not stop in sequence. Passengers are to wait around their respective zones and look out for their buses.

How do I identify my bus as there are no fixed waiting points?

Buses allocated to the respective Zones will not stop in sequence. Passengers are to wait around their respective zones and look out for their buses. There will be signages placed in front and at the side of the buses.

My previous pick up point is near PCC gate, why is my pick-up point further after the change?

As the aim is to shift all pick ups into the auxiliary road in the Yard premises, the design of the auxiliary road along PCC gate does not allow buses to stop. At the same time, the pick up points are selected with the consideration of the availability of waiting spaces.

FAQs

Will there be a delay in my departure time after the change?

As the buses will only move out in an orderly manner at 1730 hrs / 1900 hrs, a delay of 5-10 mins is to be expected for all passengers.

I am driving to work and I usually park at the open air parking lots in front of the security post at Corporate building. Am I not allowed to park my vehicle there now?

Drivers are advised to park at the Multi-Storey Carpark. Drivers are allowed to park at the open air parking lots in front of the security post, however drivers <u>MUST</u> shift their car before 5pm. This is to facilitate the entry of buses for pick up after working hours.

Can I queue on the road while waiting for my bus to arrive?

Do not queue on the road while waiting for your buses to arrive. You may wait at the sheltered bus bay or inside the Multi-Storey Carpark.
